Closing the Golf Course? Discussions between the American Golf Corporation and the City of Atlanta are proceeding. American Golf has demonstrated an interest in keeping the course open, improving the facilities, and adding new features to the course, such as a miniature golf course and a driving range, in order to cover the cost of privatization. The negotiations between CPNO and American Golf have just begun and we hope a positive arrangement can be worked out to everyone's benefit.

The CPNO Directory is nearly ready. Delivery of the new and improved CPNO Neighborhood Directory will begin in June. CPNO sponsors will have the directory delivered. The cost to non-sponsors is \$5 and directories must be purchased at CPNO monthly meetings.

World's Narrowest Street Goes One Way

Josephine Street, the narrowest street in Candler Park, announced recently that there will be no more sideswiped cars or driving onto the sidewalk to avoid oncoming cars since the street is now officially one-way only. Traffic on the street will

research, discussion and public debate.

The "One Way" movement originally arose out of safety concerns expressed over a year ago at a Josephine Street Neighborhood Watch meeting. The residents requested that the City do a traffic count and speed assessment of the cars using the street. A traffic engineer from the City attended a neighborhood meeting and the pros and cons of making the street one way were discussed at length.

A group of Josephine residents took a poll of all of the street's residents and property owners and found that of the 65 affected properties, 51, or over 75%, were in favor of making the street one way. A petition requesting the one way designation was submitted to the Atlanta City Council and several months later, the Council passed an ordinance declaring Josephine one way.

Although a lot of work went in to making the change happen, the residents are glad they stuck with it and are relieved about the new sense of order that prevails along their unusually narrow lane.
