From the President

At our April meeting the proposed plan for the redevelopment of the now defunct presidential parkway land was presented. It was very well received by those who were in attendance at the meeting. For the past two issues of this publication, we have published a copy of the plan for all the rest of the neighborhood to review and comment upon.

At our June meeting we will vote on the plan. Then the plan will be sent to the City of Atlanta and to the State Department of Transportation, and we will continue to work with both of them to see that it is carried out.

This is a plan that has been developed over the past two years, beginning with the neighborhood survey that was done in the fall of 1991. All of the meetings have been well publicized and open to anyone who wanted to attend. Everyone's input was heard and discussed; what we now have is a product of that input. Let's formalize this at our June meeting.

This month we will also look at the problem of people driving too fast through our residential neighborhood. With all the children and cats we have in Candler Park, the risk from speeders has been presenting an increasingly serious safety threat. We will have someone from the police with us and we will brainstorm ways to slow down drivers on our streets.

Please plan to attend. As usual, child care will be provided.

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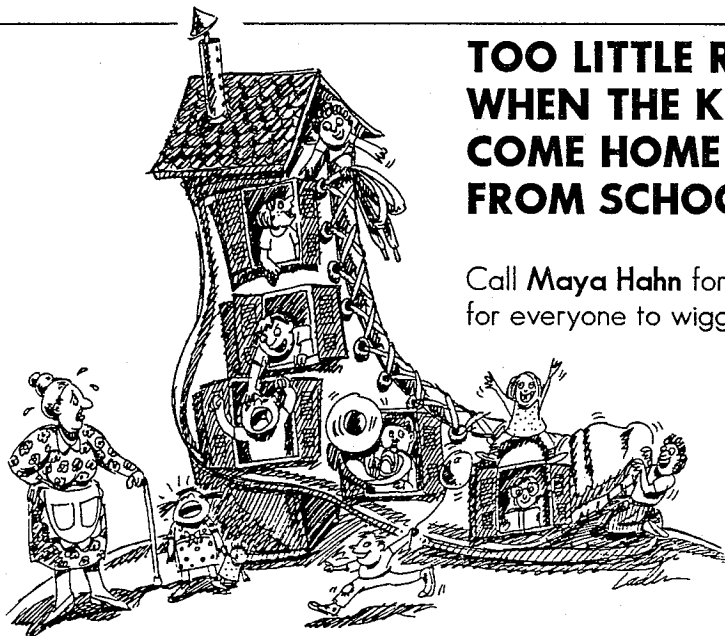
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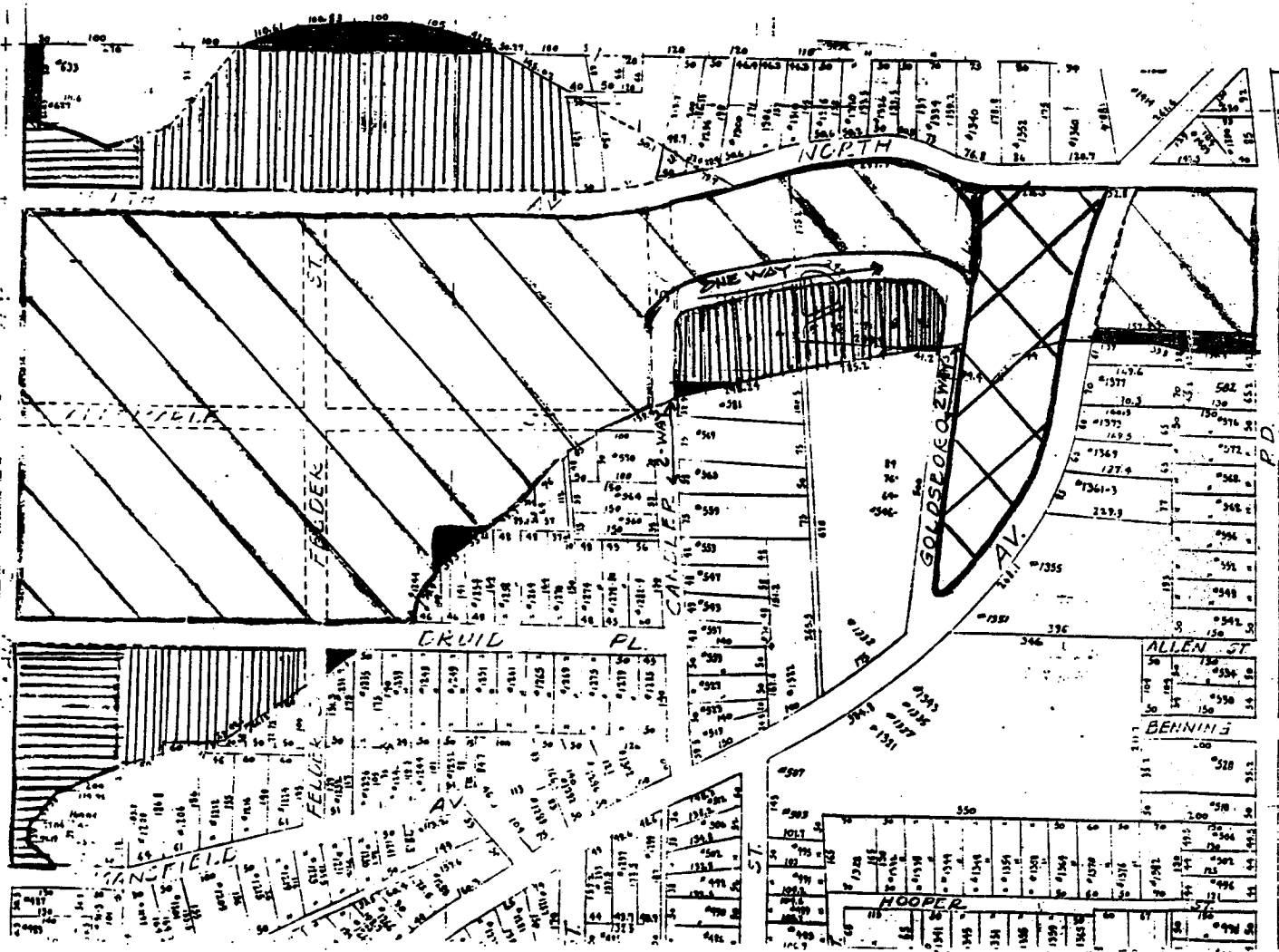
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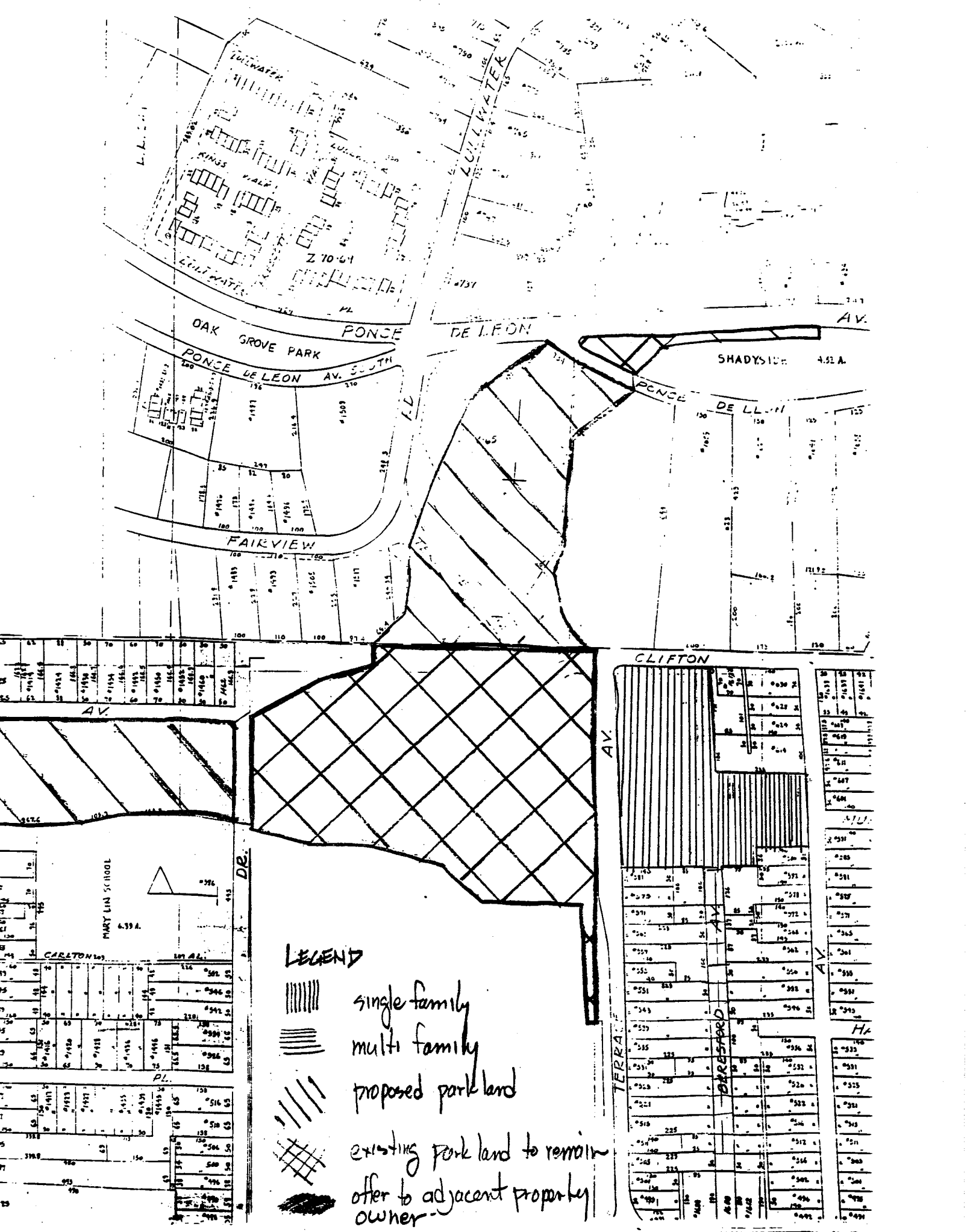
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EAST of Moreland Proposed Land Use Plan
