Bite 'em Back!

I expect many of you are equally as annoyed as I am by the mosquitoes of summer. The county board of health used to spray for them, but has ceased doing so for both financial and health reasons.

That leaves a large measure of responsibility for mosquito control on us -- particularly because of the short life span of the insect. The larvae go from egg to adult in a mere 3 - 7 days. Essentially, then, the whole cycle is approximately a month long.

The 3 - 7 day breeding stage is what we can most dramatically affect. Mosquitoes REQUIRE standing water. I'm not just talking about stagnant ponds either. Burt Tyler, with the Division of Environmental Health for the county, said mosquito breeding grounds are everywhere - and in places we wouldn't normally even THINK of. Anything: tire ruts in the mud, empty flower pots, pet drinking bowls, gutters, bird baths, old tires, plastic covering woodpiles. ANYTHING where water can sit still for just one week.

Home owners are responsible for things on their property. For anything else,

the department will come out and 1. try to remedy the problem, 2. treat the water. They use pellets of Altosid - a growth hormone regulator totally specific to mosquitoes. This kills mosquitoes in the larval stage ONLY. Not much can be done about the adults - they have no predators except fish (and maybe the occasional hand swat).

The upshot of all this is that through a neighborhood-wide effort, the mosquito level can be reduced. The county stands ready to help us. They have inspectors who will come out and help you identify problem areas on your property. They will also deal with problems on non-private property -- just call them at 508-7900 Monday through Friday.

Let's reclaim the outdoors in the evenings! I know it's mosquitoes, not muggers, that keep me off the streets in the summertime!

detectives' office will not alter the exterior plan of the building as agreed upon by the neighborhood, and is part of a nationwide law enforcement plan of "community policing".

We welcome this high-profile, 24-hour law enforcement presence in Candler Park. Completion is scheduled for June of 1994.




