FREEDOM PARK UPDATE

This month we have two important issues to consider regarding the Freedom Park Plan for redevelopment of the former Presidential Parkway land.

The first area of concern is the proposed pedestrian bridge spanning Moreland Avenue. At our November CPNO meeting, the group voted, after discussion, to consider the bridge pending further details of the construction materials and design. We should have those design and construction details from EDAW by the January meeting.

The second area for discussion is the width of the pedestrian and bicycle paths through our section of the park. EDAW has proposed a twelve foot width, which seems to be a standard. Other neighborhoods



