MONTHLY REPORT OF THE CANDLER PARK NEIGHBORHOOD ORGANIZATION

President's Report

You've probably noticed that the agenda for this month's meeting is rather short. However, the April will still be a busy month for the neighborhood. In addition to the Historic Guidelines and the Golf Tournament, CPNO is in the process of preparing a Special Public Interest Zoning Request to the city to dictate the zoning requirements for the D.O.T land that was returned to the city. Also, the neighborhood is forming committees to address the creation of signs for the major entrances to the neighborhood and to reduce the speed of people travelling through Candler Park.

At the March meeting, we discussed the commercial area at the corner of Clifton and McLendon. While the neighborhood approved a zoning variance to allow sit down dining at a deli to be run by the Horizon School, concern was expressed regarding parking in the area and its effect on the neighborhood. A Candler Park/Lake Claire joint committee was established to monitor this situation and look out for the neighborhood's best interest. I will try to keep you informed of any developments.

Candler Park Golf Tournament

On Saturday April 16th, the Candler Park Neighborhood Organization will hold a golf tournament to help fund a park beautification project. The tournament will be 18 holes with the lowest handicapped scorer receiving a \$50 prize. Additional prizes will go to winners of the "closest to the pin" and longest drive contests. 

