Brewhouse Cafe Opens in February

You may be curious about what is going to replace Good O'le Days in Little Five Points. The answer is the Brewhouse Cafe. The Cafe will be owner-operated, the owner living in close-by Cabbage Town. Here is a preview of what we can expect, come February, at the corner of McLendon and Moreland.

The Cafe will serve a wide selection of beers (16 on draft), wine, liquors and coffees. In addition, it will offer a full menu with appetizers, soups and salads and Entrees. The menu includes European, British, American and vegetarian meals. Daily specials will be available.

The Cafe will be open for Breakfast and Brunch at 10AM weekdays and 9AM weekends. Lunch will be served daily from 11AM-5PM. Dinner will be served daily after 5PM. On weekends there will be live Jazz from 11AM to 1PM and 3PM to 5PM. Blues and Jazz musicians will be featured at night on Sat. and Sun.

Be A Candler Park Golf Course Sponsor

Their work has paid off with a marked increase in the number of players. The course averages about 100 players a day - ranging from families, students, seniors, businessmen to politicians. 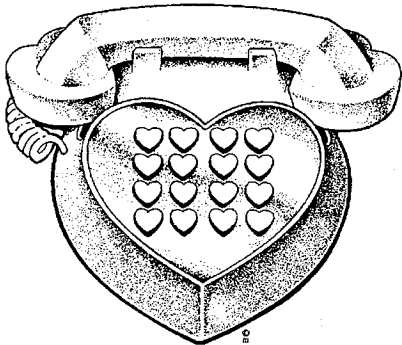

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
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
